one thousand eight hundred and twenty between Brittain Barnes
and Rachel his wife of the county of Southampton of the one party
and Joseph Russ of the aforesaid county of the other party Witnesseth
that the said Brittain Barnes and Rachel his wife for and in
consideration of the sum of eight hundred and thirty seven Dollars and
fifty two cents to the said Brittain Barnes in hand paid, the receipt
whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained and sold, and
by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and confirm unto the said
Joseph Russ his heirs and assigns for ever all that tract or
parcel of land lying and being situate on the south side of
Nottingham river in the county of Southampton aforesaid containing
Two Hundred and thirty two acres be the same more or less
Bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a large red oak in the
side of the road a corner of Sampson Pops running due north
sixteen pole, thence north fourteen and a half poles easterly
four pole to a red oak, thence due north one hundred and eighty
two pole to a black jack a corner of Sampson Pops and Robert
Mellay line thence north 48 Degrees east Two hundred two and
a half pole to a black gum in the pine branch thence south
30 Degrees east thirty four pole to a pine thence south 47 degrees
east two pole to a pine a corner of Nathaniel Bourshers thence
south 46 Degrees west thirty two pole to a small pine thence
south 41 Degrees east Ninety two pole to a red oak in Thomas
Vancours line, thence, three south 46 degrees east Three hundred and
thirty two pole to the beginning. To have and to hold the
said tract or parcel of land with all and singular the premises and
appurtenances thereto belonging or any other appurtenances unto him
the said Joseph Russ his heirs and assigns for ever, and the said Brittain
Barnes and Rachel his wife for themselves, their heirs, executors
administrators or assigns, both covinanted and agreed to and with the
said Joseph Russ his heirs, executors, administrators or assigns to warrant
and forever defend the title of the said premises against the
claims or demands of any person or persons whatsoever In Witness
