Polly Drake, and her heirs forever, and the s^d James Griffins and Mealy his wife for themselves, their heirs, executors, administrators, etc. by these presents covenant and grant to and with the s^d Polly Drake her heirs and assigns that they will by these presents warrant and defend all right, title, claim or demands of any person or persons claiming or depending the same or any part or parcel thereof.
