made and entered into the 28th day of March in the year one thousand eight hundred and eighteen Between Timothy Syms and Rebecca Syms his wife of the County of Southampton of the one part and Robert Mercer of the same County of the other part (Witnesseth) that the said Timothy Syms and Rebecca his wife for and in consideration sum of one Hundred and Thirty Dollars by the said Robert Mercer to the said Timothy Syms and Rebecca his wife have paid at or before the making of this Indenture the receipt whereof is hereby by the said Timothy Syms and Rebecca his wife acknowledged and the said Robert Mercer paid by hims Executor, Admors and assigns as by these presents appears and forever is charged. have bargained and sold and by this Indenture bought, bargain, sell, alien and forever convey unto the said Robert Mercer and by hims Executor, Admors & assigns a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton aforesaid containing the estimated twenty acres in the same more or less and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a lightwood post a corner between William Bond and said tract of land thence a line of marked trees between said William Bond and said tract of land to the hog pen branch thence down said branch to the deep branch thence up the said deep branch to John Crumpler sen line thence a line of marked trees between said Lucy Bregh and said tract of land to the said lightwood post the beginning To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging to any wise appurtenancing unto the said Robert Mercer and his heirs Executors or assigns forever with the reversion & reversionary remainder remaining right Syms and profits thereof to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Robert Mercer and his heirs Executors and assigns forever and the said Timothy Syms and Rebecca his wife with full assent and by these presents forever release the right and title of said tract or parcel of land with all and singular its appurtenances to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Robert Mercer and his heirs Executors and assigns forever In witness whereof they the said Timothy Syms and
