eighty Dollars of lawful money to them in hand paid

of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged,
have bargained & sold & by these presents doth bargain and
sell unto the said Thomas Parton his heirs and assigns
forever, a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being
in the County and parish aforesaid, containing by estimation
one hundred acres to the same more or less and bounded
