This Indenture made and entered into this eight day
of April One thousand eight hundred and eighteenth, Between
Elizabeth Milly of the Town of Suffolk County of Nansemond and State of
Virginia of the one part and Edward Riddick of the City of Richmond
and State aforesaid, Witnesses that the said Elizabeth Milly in con-
sideration of one dollar to her in hand paid by the said Edward Riddick
at or before the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and do by these presents
doth bargain and sell unto the said Edward Riddick his heirs and
assigns five hundred and eleven acres of Land in the County of
Suffolk adjoining the Lands of James Blount, Mrs. Blount
and James Ingham Purchase the purchase of Martha Tyler the same
being my Power part of the Lands of my husband Jeremiah Tyler the same
doth I have and to hold all and singular the appurtenances
thereunto belonging unto the said Edward Riddick his heirs and
assigns forever, And the said Elizabeth Milly for herself and her
heirs to the said Land with all and singular the premises appurtenances
before mentioned unto the said Edward Riddick and his heirs and
assigns in fee simple for ever, from the claims or claims of her and her
heirs, and of all and every person or persons whatsoever, shall will
and do against and against persons, by these presents, In Witness
whereof the said Elizabeth Milly have hereunto set her hand and seal
