

Lewis Augustus & John Anthony, and the portions of the said Lewis Augustus Whitehead & John Anthony Whitehead being distributable agreeable to the law made and provided for the distribution of intestate Estates among the representatives of the said Lewis Augustus & John Anthony Whiteheads, and the said Samuel M. Whitehead one of the representatives of the said Lewis Augustus Whitehead and of John Anthony Whitehead being desirous of selling his interest in the Estates of the said Lewis Augustus Whitehead and John Anthony Whitehead. *Now*

This Indenture made this twenty third day of June in the year 1818 between Samuel Mordaugh Whitehead of the one part and Colthrop Pond of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Samuel M. Whitehead for and in consideration of the sum of fifty Dollars unto him in hand paid by the said Colthrop Pond at or before the usual making and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and of the same doth fully acquit and exonerate the said Colthrop Pond, the said Samuel M. Whitehead, hath granted, bargained, sold, aliened, released and confirmed and by these presents doth grant, bargain, sell, alien, release and confirm unto the said Colthrop Pond all his right, title, interest, claim and demand of in, unto, or in any wise affecting from the Estates of Lewis Augustus Whitehead, and John Anthony Whitehead to the said Colthrop Pond to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Colthrop Pond his heirs and assigns forever, and the said Samuel M. Whitehead for himself his heirs, executors and administrators, doth covenant and agree at and with the said Colthrop Pond to warrant and defend the said right title, interest, claim and demand herein conveyed and intended to be conveyed as is before recited, unto the said Colthrop Pond his heirs and assigns forever against him the said Samuel M. Whitehead his heirs, executors and administrators, and against the claim or claims of all and every other person and persons whatsoever. In testimony whereof the said Samuel M.
