

Lewis Augustus & John Anthony, and the portions of the said Lewis Augustus Whitehead & John Anthony Whitehead being distributable agreeable to the said made and provided for the distribution of intestate Estates among the representatives of the said Lewis Augustus & John Anthony Whitehead, and the said Samuel McWhithead one of the representatives of the said Lewis Augustus Whitehead and of John Anthony Whitehead being desirous of selling his interest in the Estates of the said Lewis Augustus Whitehead and John Anthony Whitehead. Now

This Indenture made this twenty second day of June in the year 1818 between Samuel M. McWhithead of the one part and Colthorpe Pond of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Samuel McWhithead for and in consideration of the sum of fifty Dollars unto him in hand paid by the said Colthorpe Pond at or before the concluding and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and of the same debt fully acquit and extinguished the said Colthorpe Pond, the said Samuel M. McWhithead, hath granted bargained sold, aliened, released and confirmed and by these presents doth grant, bargain, sell, alien, release and confirm unto the said Colthorpe Pond all his right, title, Interest, claim and demand, of in, and to, or in any wise apertaining from the Estates of Lewis Augustus Whitehead, and John Anthony Whitehead to the said Colthorpe Pond to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Colthorpe Pond his heirs, and assigns forever, and the said Samuel McWhithead for himself his heirs, executors and administrators, doth covenant and agree that and with the said Colthorpe Pond to warrant and defend the said right title, interest, claim and demand herein conveyed and intended to be conveyed as is before recited, unto the said Colthorpe Pond his heirs and assigns forever against him the said Samuel McWhithead, his heirs, executors and administrators, and against the claim or claims of all and every other person and persons whatsoever. In testimony whereof the said Samuel McWhithead hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal the day and year first above written.
