Bailey of the County of Putnam of the first part, and Willie Delt of the County of Southampton of the second part, Witnesseth that the said Alfred S. Bailey in consideration of the sum of nine hundred dollars to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge, have given, granted, bargained and sold, do by these presents do give, grant, bargain and sell unto the said Willie J. Delt and his heirs &c. one hundred & twenty three acres of land, be the same more or less, lying on the south side of Black Water Swamp, and in the County of Southampton, which land is known by the name of Millfords old place, and bounded as follows (To wit) by Joshua Bedlow on the south, ending on a swamp known by the name of Tarapin Swamp, Black Water Swamp on the east, and the lands of the said Willie J. Delt. Then above a live land was secured to Edwin Bailey by a Deed in Trust for a certain sum of money therein mentioned from Thomas Millford, and the said Alfred S. Bailey was Trustee the said Deed to have and to hold, the said tract of parcel of land with its appurtenances to him the said Willie J. Delt his heirs &c. and the said Alfred S. Bailey as Trustee for himself his heirs &c. and assigns the aforesaid tract of parcel of land together with its appurtenances unto him the said Willie J. Delt his heirs and assigns, do share and will forever warrant and defend the right title &c. In witness whereof the said Alfred S. Brack and Mary his wife and their heirs &c. one hundred and twenty three acres of land, be the same more or less, lying on the south side of Black Water Swamp, and in the County of Southampton, which land is known by the name of Millfords old place, and bounded as follows (To wit) by Joshua Bedlow on the south, ending on a swamp known by the name of Tarapin Swamp, Black Water Swamp on the east, and the lands of the said Willie J.
