white oak standing in Jordan Denson's line thence along a line of
marked trees to a pine a corner tree standing in Henry Obary's
line thence along the said Obary's line to Elisha Lewis's line
and down the said Lewis's line to a pine a corner tree standing
in Barnabus Davis's line thence through a meadow down the
house line cross the road down to the bar at the beginning
Containing by estimation Forty acres, be the same more or
less, together with all and singular the appurtenances whatsoever
of the premises & reversions, remainder & remainders, yearly rents
rents, issues & profits thereof & of every part & parcel thereof
To have and to hold the said Forty acres of land with
the tenements, hereditaments & all and singular other the
premises therein before mentioned or intended to be bargained
and sold & every part & parcel thereof with every of their
rights, members and appurtenances unto the said Jesse Bracy
his heirs & assigns forever And the said Thos. E. Broock & Mary his
wife for themselves and their heirs the said Forty acres of land with
all and singular the premises & appurtenances before mentioned
unto the said Jesse Bracy his heirs & assigns free from the claim or
claiming of them the said Thos. E. Broock & Mary his wife or either
of them their or either of their heirs & of all and every person or
person whatsoever shall will and do warrant & forever defend by
