This Indenture made this twenty eighth day
of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & eighteenth
Between Wiley S. Delt of the County of Southampton of the one part
and Joshua Proctor of the aforesaid County of the other part Witness
eth that the said Wiley S. Delt for the consideration of the sum
to him in hand paid by the said Joshua
Proctor the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have given
granted, bargained, and sold and by these presents do give, grant, bargain
and sell to the said Joshua Proctor his heirs and assigns, one certain
Tract or parcel of land, lying and being in the aforesaid County on
the west side of Black water swamp being part of a tract, lately belong-
ing to the estate of Johnston Williford dec'd, containing one and
one third acres more or less, and bounded as follows. Viz Beginning
at the main Proctor Road on the east side of the cattle branch
on the line thereof commencing twenty feet wide and so con-
tinuing to the main road of little swamp on the present lot
of partly a new cattle way, and partly an old path way, trees
marked, or chopped on the west side of said path. So I leave it
to hold, said tract or parcel of land together with all & sing-
ular its appurtenances to him the said Joshua Proctor and his
heirs forever, and the said Wiley S. Delt his heirs, executors & administrators
the said tract or parcel of land with its appurtenances to him the said
Joshua Proctor his heirs and assigns shall and with warrant and signed
