 passed January the first day of the year eighteen hundred and eighteen
 entitled "An act establishing several Towns" among other things
 it was enacted that ten acres of land at Brown's Ferry of Nottingham
 the property of Clements Rochelle in the County of Southampton &c
 as the same shall be laid off into Lots with convenient streets be
 established a Town by the names of Monroe and that John Thomas
 James Rochelle John Rochelle Benjamin Blunt jr Jacob Tardent
 and Williams L Enright Gentlemen, more fully appointed trustees
 for the purposes therein mentioned and purposed the said Ten
 acres of land hath been laid off into convenient streets agreeable
 to the before enacted act of the general Assembly and the said
 Clements Rochelle hath sold two of the said Lots known in
 the plan of the town by numbers 11 and 25 to a certain
