Whereas William Deale of the County of Southampton stands justly indebted unto Charlotte Carr the sum of one hundred and eight Dollars which he is to pay Eighteen Dollars per year for six years for the support of a female Bastard child which the said William Deale got by the said Charlotte Carr the first Eighteen Dollars is to be paid on the twenty eighth day of February one Thousand eight hundred and sixteen and is to be paid the twenty eighth day of February every year until the above mentioned sum of one hundred and eight Dollars is paid if the child lives as long and in order to secure William Deale of the County aforesaid for being his security for the different payments of the said above mentioned sum of one hundred and eight dollars is paid if the child dies as long as he is agreed to make over the estate or property hereafter mentioned upon the terms hereafter expressed
