Johnston hath for and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred Dollars to them in hand paid the receipt of which they do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained, sold, sold and by these presents, doth grant bargain sell unto the said Solomon High and to his heirs and assigns forever an certain Lot of ground, situated in the town of Morrore in ~~the~~ County of Southampton and known and designated in the map or plat of the Town as Lot No. 8 and bounded on the North street from the river to the junction of Madison street thence up Madison street thirty five yards to a corner stone from thence to the river at the water edge as a front from thence down the river in the edge of the water to the beginning supposed to contain half an acre &c. the same more or less To have and to hold the said Lot of land with all and singular the advantages and emoluments hereafter arising unto him the said Solomon High and to his heirs and assigns forever and the said Clement Rochelle and Nancy his wife and the said Benjamin W. Johnston each doth hereby respectively warrant and defend each of their respective Interest in the said Lot of Land unto him the said Solomon High and to his heirs and assigns forever against the claim of them or either of them their heirs executors, administrators for any person whatsoever In witness whereof the parties to this deed have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals the day and date first herein written.
