 Between John Morton of the one part and Henry Senoo of the other part
 all of the County of Southampton & State of Virginia, Witnesseth that
 the said John Morton for and in consideration of the sum of thirty
 Dollars good and lawful money of this Commonwealth to him in
 hand paid by the said Henry Senoo the receipt whereof the said
 John Morton doth hereby acknowledge himself fully and amply
 satisfied contented and paid, hath granted bargained sold aliened
 conveyed and confirmed, and by these presents doth grant bargain
 sell, alien & confirm unto the said Henry Senoo his heirs and
 assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land, containing by estimate
 three one hundred and sixty acres lying and being in the 10th section
 of section twenty eight of Township Thirtieth North in Range
 one east in Tract appropriated by the act aforesaid for military
 bounty in the Territory of Illinois Number 3000. To have and to
 hold the said quarter section of Land with the appurtenances
 thereof unto the said Henry Senoo his heirs and assigns forever
 with all and singular the appurtenances unto the said land belonging
 or in any wise appertaining unto the same to have and to
 hold of the same unto the said Henry Senoo his heirs and
 assigns forever and the said John Morton for himself his heirs
 executors, administrators and assigns doth covenant and grant to and
 with the said Henry Senoo his heirs and assigns that they
