W^m Thorne hath granted, bargained, sold, aliened, & transferred, and by these presents doth grant, bargain and sell alien and transfer unto the said Henry Lenox his heirs and assigns forever, all their right, title, interest, claims or demands whatsoever to the said several devises and legacies in the said last will and testament of Thomas Wood dec^d which the said William Thorne has in right of his said wife Catharine P. and which he will be entitled to when his said wife Catharine P. attains the age of twenty one years, and also all the right, title, interest, claim or demands for which may hereafter accrue to him in right of his said wife, by the death of the said infant devises and legates of Thomas Wood dec^d for any of them to the said devises and legacies respectively, gives them in the said last will and testament together with all and every advantage, emolument and interest in any wise appertaining to, or to be derived from the estate of the said Thomas Wood dec^d To have and to hold to the said Henry Lenox his heirs and assigns to the only proper use and behoof of the said Henry Lenox his heirs and assigns forever in as ample a manner as the said William Thorne would or could have done in and this conveyance had never been made and the said William Thorne in right of his said wife for themselves and their heirs, the said devises and legacies and every part thereof against themselves and their heirs and against all and every other persons and persons whatsoever to the said Henry Lenox, dec^d, shall, and will warrant and forever defend by these presents.
