This Indenture made this seventh day of August in the
year of our Lord Christ one thousand eight hundred and eighteenth
between Rowland Wood of the one part, and Henry Linn of the
other part all of the County of Southampton parish of Kilmory
and State of Virginia. Witnesseth, that whereas the said Rowland
Wood is or will be entitled to a certain portion or dividend arising
from the sale of lands, slaves and personal property devised and
bequeathed to the said Rowland Wood, in the last will & testament of
his father Thomas Wood dec^d and whereas the said Rowland Wood may
by the death of the infant devise and legatee of the said Thomas
Wood dec^d be entitled to a certain portion of the estate devised to
Bathurine P. Thorne late Lutharine P. Wood or any other legatee
by the said Thomas Wood dec^d the said Rowland Wood for and in
consideration of the sum of One hundred pounds current money of
Virginia by the said Henry Linn to the said Rowland Wood in
hand paid the receipt whereof the said Rowland Wood doth hereby
acknowledge, and forever acquit and discharge the said Henry Linn
his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever the said Rowland
Wood hath granted, bargained, sold, aliened, and transferred, and by
these presents doth grant, bargain and sell, alien and transfer unto
the said Henry Linn his heirs and assigns forever, all his right title
interest, claim or demand whatsoever to the said several devise
and legacies in the said last will and testament of Thomas
Wood dec^d which the said Rowland Wood has or right of
the said dec^d wife and which he will be entitled to and also
all the right title interest, claim or demand whatsoever which
may hereafter accrue to him by the said infant death and
devise and legacies of Thomas Wood dec^d or any of them to the
devisees and legatees respectively given them in the said
