This Indenture made this 10<sup>th</sup> day of July in  
the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighteenth between  
Nicholas Bryant and Nancy his wife of the county of Southampton  
and state of Virginia of the one part and Lewis Worrell of the  
County of Southampton and state of the other part. Witnesseth that the said  
Nicholas Bryant and Nancy his wife for and in consideration of the  
sum of Eighty one Dollars to them in hand paid by the said Lewis  
Worrell, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have  
bargained and sold and by these presents do and each of them doth  
bargain and sell unto the said Lewis Worrell his heirs and assigns  
a certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the aforesaid  
County of Southampton and state of Virginia in Saint Luke's Parish  
containing by estimation twenty two acres, be the same more or less  
and bounded as followeth. To wit. Beginning at a black gum or  
new corner in the spring branch, near the water hole in Land Court's  
line thence down the run of the said branch to the water hole, thence  
along Court's line to a white oak standing on the south side of the spring  
branch near the water hole, thence along said Court's line to a black gum  
a corner in Lewis Worrell's line, thence along said Worrell's line along  
the road to a pine in other corner in said Worrell's line, thence along  
said Worrell's line to a bunch of Box in the timber near another  
corner in said Worrell's line to a lightwood limb or post a new  
corner in said Worrell's line thence a line of new marked trees
