Know all men by these presents that whereas Nathan Williams of the county of Southampton in the State of Virginia on the fifteenth day of February 1817 did by deed convey to Benjamin Barnes in trust a certain parcel of land lying and being in the aforesaid county supposed to be about fifty acres and the said conveyance being entered into by us the parties thereto for the express purpose of securing the payment of a debt due and owing to Jacob Barnes from the said Nathan Williams and whereas from a written certificate from under the hand of the said Jacob Barnes bearing date 26th day of June 1818 in which the said Jacob Barnes certifies that on the aforesaid 26th day of June 1818 that Britton Bryant the lawfully administrator of the said Nathan Williams did paid to the said Jacob Barnes in full of the debt of the said Nathan Williams due the debt and interest for which the aforesaid land was conveyed in trust to secure Now therefore the said Benjamin Barnes Trustee do in compliance with the said obligation of trust do hereby release to the heirs of the said Nathan Williams due all my right, title and interest in and to the said land in any way belonging to them the said lawfull heirs of the said Nathan Williams due and do by these presents warrant to the said heirs all the title thus conveyed as aforesaid against myself my heirs, executors and administrators to them the said heirs forever free from the claim of myself my heirs, executors or administrators In witness whereof I said Benjamin Barnes trustee as aforesaid have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal on this 14th day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and Eighty eight
