This Indenture made this sixth day of January in the year of
our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighteenth by and between Robert
Kennedy & Sally Kennedy his wife (late Sally Carr daughter of Sipe Carr late of
Christian County & state of Kentucky) of the one part & Elisha Darden of
Southampton County Virginia of the other part. Witnesseth that the said
Robert Kennedy and Sally his wife for & in consideration of the sum of three
thousand and fifty five Dollars to him the said Robert Kennedy in hand
paid by the said Elisha Darden at & before the executing & sealing of
these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged they the said
Robert Kennedy & Sally his wife for themselves their heirs executors and
administrators have granted bargained sold aliened & confirmed & by these
presents do grant bargain sell alien and confirmed unto the said Elisha
Darden his heirs & assigns forever one certain tract parcel or Estate and
lying & being situated in the aforesaid County of Southampton on the west side
of the Cedar swamp containing by estimation one hundred and sixty five
acres more or less it being one half of a tract of Land granted by Patent
under the signature of His Excellency Thomas Lee Esquire to Robert Carr
for three hundred thirty acres which Patent bears date the first day of June
one thousand seven hundred & eighty seven by the last will & testament of
the said Robert Carr to his son Benjamin confirmed by the said John Carr
to his son Thomas Carr who sold & conveyed it to Sipe Carr the father of
the said Sally & under a record of the County Court of Southampton for a
distribution of the lands of the said Sipe Carr placed amongst his
children the said one hundred & sixty five acres was assigned to the said
Sally as her portion of the Lands of which her said Father Sipe Carr
died seized & possessed To have & to hold the same bargained
premises together with all & singular the rents issues profits emoluments
& appurtenances out of the same in manner & form as aforesaid
