This Indenture

made and entered into this 10th day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty four by and between George Whitfield of the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia of the first part Davis Bryant of the same County and State of the second part and Jacob Barnes of the said County and State of the third part Whereas the said George Whitfield did within the year 1854 before Rankin Whitfield died and gave bond for the land which is the subject of this Indenture for his legal performance in respect of the said estate & for the satisfaction of the said Jacob Barnes the said George Whitfield is willing and desirous effectually to assure and secure the said Jacob Barnes his heirs executors and administrators from any possible injury which may or shall hereafter accrue in any way on account of the aforesaid Securitship Now therefore This Indenture Witnesseth that for the purpose aforesaid the consideration of the premises and for the further sum of one dollar current money of the United States to him in hand paid by the said Davis Bryant at or before the executing and delivery of these presents the full receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and from every part of which the said Davis Bryant and all his legal representatives are forever released quitted and discharged have granted bargained and sold & do hereby grant bargain and sell unto the said Davis Bryant his heirs & assigns the tract of Land which is bounded by the following named persons lands to wit John Barrett Nathan Williams Bennett Barnes's Nancy Newsum's the said Jacob Barnes's said tract of land is supposed to contain near two hundred acres be the same more or less said land called & known by the name of the rising Ford lying and being in the aforesaid County & State To have and to hold the before described tract of Land & every improvement on the same the right title interest and estate whatsoever of him the said George Whitfield of in & to the same to him the said Davis Bryant his heirs executors administrators forever to the only proper use & behoof of him the said Davis Bryant his heirs executors administrators & assigns forever And must nevertheless if the said George Whitfield or one of his heirs executors administrators shall or does so administer or manage the estate of the aforesaid Rankin Whitfield do as to render said the land to which the said Jacob Barnes stands bound one of the Securitites for the said George Whitfield's lawful performance as aforesaid then this
