

Indenture and every thing here contained is to be void and of none effect but if the said George Whitfield his heirs executors administrators shall fail to discharge the aforesaid land by their legal performance in the settlement of any part of the estate of Ralph Whitfield dec'd as aforesaid & such share or shares hereafter be lent or acc'd thereof the said Isaac Barnes his heirs executors or administrators shall pay money or in any way become sufficient or acc'd of the security ship as aforesaid that in every such case by complaint thereof being made to the said David Bryant or his executors or administrators for the aforesaid Isaac Barnes or his legal representatives whereupon the said David Bryant or shall may sell and dispose of from time to time so many acres of the before described land as will be sufficient to discharge all such claims or obligations to said Isaac Barnes his heirs executors or administrators all monies & all personal troubles that may accrue in acc't of the before mentioned security ship which disposal of said land if any shall be let the Perry Grove on the premises at publick auction advertising the day & place of such disposal at three or more publick places within the aforesaid county and three weeks previous to the day of disposal as aforesaid and in case the said land or any part thereof shall remain unsold at the time said land shall be disposed of so that the said Isaac Barnes his heirs executors or administrators and thereby under no obligation whatsoever in acc't of said security ship David Bryant &c is to return to the said George Whitfield all the little shares hereby transferred to him & in case the said David Bryant shall die before the execution of this Trust his executors or administrators shall carry this indenture into effect and operation & the said George Whitfield himself his heirs executors or administrators hereby covenants to and with the said David Bryant his heirs executors or administrators that the aforesaid Land against the claims and claims of all and every person & persons what soever with by these presents warrantly forever defend & satisfaction whereof we the said parties have hereunto subscribed our names & affixed our seals on the day & year first above written
