Mason and Charlotte E. his wife parties to a certain bill for the conveyance of certain white lying in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia the said Margaret of the County of Southampton bearing date on the fourteenth day of March 1818 had hereto appeared personally appeared before us in our County appeared and the said Charlotte E. Mason being examined by us privately apart from her husband, & having she did avow and fully explained to her, that the said Charlotte E. Mason acknowledged the same to be her act and deed and declared she had willingly, signed, sealed and delivered the same, and she as well the aforesaid Armistead J. Mason her husband desired us to certify their and each of their acknowledgments to the Clerk of the County Court of Southampton in order that the said conveyance may be recorded. This Indenture made this first day of September in the year one thousand Eight hundred & eighteen. Between Matthew Johnson and Matthew Shuster his wife of Southampton County North Carolina of the one part & Judith Shuster of Southampton County Virginia of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Matthew Shuster and Matthew his wife for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and ninety five Dollars to them in hand paid by the said Judith Shuster the receipt whereof is hereby fully acknowledged, hath given grant, bargain, sold, confirmed and made over and by their presents do give grant, bargain, sell, confirm and make over unto the said Judith Johnson her heirs and assigns forever one tract or parcel of land which fell to the said Matthew Johnson & Matthew his wife by the division of the lands that belonged to the estate of Harry Johnson late intestate lying and being in the County of Southampton aforesaid and bounded as follows, bounded by the said Judith Johnson's name, then by Charles Harrison William Harrison & Thomas Chapel and thence by the rocky marsh, containing forty acres to the same more or less. To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land with all the appurtenances thereof unto the said Judith Johnson her heirs
