 William Kirby and Elizabeth Kirby of the County of Sampson and
 State of North Carolina of the one part and Henry Porter of the
 County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the other part Witnesseth
 that the said Mr Kirby & Elizabeth his wife for and in consideration
 of the sum of Five hundred Dollars good & lawful money of Virginia to
 them in hand paid on or before the sealing and delivery of these presents
 the receipt whereof we the said Mr Kirby & Elizabeth his wife doth
 hereby acknowledge hath granted, bargained and sold, aliened, confirmed
 unto the said Henry Porter & to his heirs and assigns forever one certain
 tract or parcel of Land containing by estimation one hundred & eighty
 two acres, be the same more or less, situate being a part of a tract of land
 belonging to the estate of Henry Turner dec'd lying in the aforesaid County
 & bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a stake near the spring on
 Turner's line thence S. E. part to Perry's line thence along
 Turner's line to Porter's line thence Porter's line to Perry's line thence
 Perry's line to Francis's line said line to the Deep branch thence down the
 said branch as it meanders to the beginning containing by estimation
 one hundred and eighty two acres more or less To have and to hold
 the said one hundred and eighty two acres of Land with all and
 singular the appurtenances thereunto belonging to the said Henry
 Porter his heirs and assigns forever to the only proper use & behoof
