This Indenture made this eleventh day of August in the year of Christ
 one thousand eight hundred and eighteen Between Littlebury Jones and Avarilla
 Jones both of the County of Southampton State of Virginia of the first part, and
 John Holmes of the same County State of the second part, and John Urguhart of
 the same County State of the third part Whereas the said Littlebury Jones and
 Avarilla Jones are jointly indebted to the said John Urguhart in the sum of
 seventy five Dollars and twenty five cents to be paid to the said John Urguhart
 on the first day of November one thousand eight hundred and eighteen, as by a
 bond bearing date on the eleventh day of August 1818 more fully appears, which
 debt the said Littlebury Jones & Avarilla Jones are willing and desirous to secure
 Now This Indenture witnesses that for and in consideration of the premises
 and also for the further consideration of one Dollar, to the said Littlebury
 Jones & Avarilla Jones in hand paid by the said John Holmes at before the
 sealing and signing of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 that the said Littlebury Jones & Avarilla Jones have granted, bargained, sold
 & confirmed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell & confirm to the
 said John Holmes his heirs and assigns forever, a certain tract or parcel of
 land lying and being in the County of Southampton containing by estimate
 about thirty eight and a quarter acres Bounded by the land of John D.
 Moore Richard Glen and Joseph Jones it being the same land whereon the
 said Littlebury Jones now resides with all and singular the appurtenances
 to the said tract or parcel of land belonging, and all the estate right title &
 interest of the said Littlebury Jones and Avarilla Jones, or either of them, in and to
 the said granted or intended to be granted tract or parcel of land premises do
 have and to hold the said hereby granted tract or parcel of land premises
 unto the said John Holmes his heirs and assigns forever, and the said Littlebury
 Jones and Avarilla Jones for themselves, their heirs, executors, administrators
 or parcel of land, promising to the said John Holmes his heirs, executors, administrators
 and assigns, against them the said Littlebury Jones, Avarilla Jones, their heirs, executors
 & administrators, against all and every person or persons whatsoever, shall and will
 warrant and forever defend by these presents. Upon trust nevertheless that
 the said John Holmes his heirs, executors & assigns shall permit the said
 Littlebury Jones to remain in quiet and peaceable possession of the
