This Indenture made this 18th day of October one thousand eight hundred and
eighty and Lons Jones & wife Polly of Southampten County of the one part
and Stafford Kimp of the said County of the other part Witnesseth All whereas the
said Lons Jones & wife Polly for and in consideration of the sum of four hundred
fifty [£]pounds to them in hand paid by the said Kimp the receipt whereof is to be seen
and acknowledged and hath granted bargained and sold aliened conveyed
and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell alien convey
and forever confirm unto the said Stafford Kimp his heirs and assigns forever
one certain tract or parcel of land containing one hundred acres or thereabouts
more or less situated lying and being in the County of Southampten which is
a part of the tract of land formerly belonging to James Lons dec^d and
bounded by the land following first beginning at a black gum in a branch
that leads into the Indigo branch a corner of Averill's former Land
thence along the river line to a lightwood stub a corner of Littlebury
Jones's things along 1st Littlebury Jones line to a corner pine at some
blades the pine standing in a small branch thence down the various
courses of the said branch to the Indigo branch to Richard Blew's line the
run of said Indigo branch being the dividing line thence down the various
courses of 2^d branch to Thomas Gray's line in said branch thence down the
branch to the mouth of the small branch first named thence up the
various courses of the small branch to the beginning black gum and also
all trees woods underwoods commons common of pastures profits commodities
advantages emoluments and hereditaments whatsoever to the said tract or parcel
of land above mentioned belonging or in any way appertaining or in or upon
the same growing happening or arising and also all the divisions or divisions
remainings and remainders rents issues and profits and emoluments and parcels
thereof & also all the titles right title interest claim and demand whatsoever
whenever the above mentioned Lons and wife of in and to the said premises above
mentioned and every part thereof to have and to hold all and singular
the said premises above mentioned and every part and parcel thereof with the
appurtenances unto the said Stafford Kimp his heirs and assigns forever
the said Lons and wife for themselves their heirs &c the said tract of Land and
every part thereof against ourselves and our heirs and against all other persons
persons do forever pass and defend In witness whereof we the said Lons
