This Indenture made this 10<sup>th</sup> day of November one thousand eight hundred and  
Eighteen between Thomas R Collie and Lucy his wife of the County of Southampton  
and state of Virginia of the one part, and Jas. B Kendall of the State of Pennsylvania  
of the other part, Witnesseth that the said Thomas R Collie and Lucy his  
wife have for and in consideration of the sum of five thousand Dollars to them  
in hand by the said Jas. B Kendall the receipt of which they and each of them  
do hereby acknowledge, have granted bargained sold, aliened enfeoffed and confirmed  
by these presents, with warranty, bargains, alien enfeoff and confirm unto the said  
Jas. B Kendall and to his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract, piece or  
parcel of Land, situated Lying and lying in the said County of Southampton  
containing the same tract which was given by Mordy Collie to the said  
Thomas to him his heirs and assigns before reference being had to the will  
of the said Mordy which is on record in the office of the said County, the same  
will fully appear, containing by a late Survey Eight hundred and forty  
two acres be the same more or less and bounded by the lands of John Colchow & Richard Simmon  
on the north on the East by the land of John Colchow & Richard Simmon  
on the South by the Lands of Robert Kirk, on the west by the Chapmanack  
swamp To have and to hold the said tract piece or parcel of Land with  
all singular the premises appurtenances and improvements of every descrip-  
tion, comprehending and embracing the water mill, with all and  
singular its privilages and appurtenances of every description unto him the  
said Jas. B Kendall and to his heirs and assigns forever against the  
claims and demands of them the said Thomas R Collie and Lucy his  
wife, their heirs and assigns and against the claim and demand  
of all and every other person or persons whatsoever lawfully warranting  
and defending the title of the whole of the land and premises
