This Indenture made this twentieth day of April in the year of our Lord one
 thousand eight hundred and eighteenth by and between William Coll of
 Southampton County Virginia of the first part Simon Murphy of the same County and
 State of the second part and Will. Murphy of the same County and State of the
 third part. Witnesseth that whereas the above named William Coll and Simon
 Murphy hath executed two notes for the payment of money viz one to
 John Coll for the sum of one hundred and twenty one Dollars and sixty three
 Cents which bears date the twentieth day of May one thousand eight
 hundred and sixteen and is made payable with interest from its date, the
 other to Burwell Beal for one hundred and thirty Dollars date the
 fourteenth day of March one thousand eight hundred and eighteen and
 made payable with 1 interest from its date In both of which
