This Indenture

made this twentieth day of November in the
 year of our Lord Christ 1818 Between Samuel Champion and Elizabeth
 his wife (late Elizabeth Wynn) of the County of Sussex & State of Virginia
 of the one part Barham Wynn of the same County & State of the other part
 Witnesseth that the said Samuel Champion & Elizabeth his wife for and in
 consideration of the sum of thirty three hundred and ninety seven dollars and
 50¢ in hand paid by the said Barham Wynn the receipt of which they do
 hereby acknowledge, both granted, bargained, sold, aliened, released & confirmed &
 by these presents for themselves, their heirs and assigns, do grant, bargain, and
 sell, alien release and confirm unto the said Barham Wynn his heirs & assigns
 forever one certain tract or parcel of land, lying being and situate in the
 County of Southampton and State of Virginia and bounded as follows.
 Beginning at the main run of Nacogan swamp at the bridge across the same
 near Wynn's mill, thence down the main run of said swamp to a persimmon
 tree a corner for Robert Nicholson thence along said Nicholson's line to a red oak
 thence to a black jack stump a corner in said Nicholson's survey thence
 to a pine a corner for Selks thence to a black gum corner for Colia Fort
 and Selks thence to a pine a corner for Selks and Wynn thence to a
 white oak corner for Selks and Wynn thence to a cherry tree thence to a
 pine on side of the old road thence down said road bounded by Thomas
 Wynn land to the beginning at the bridge. Containing three hundred
 twenty seven and one half acres be the same more or less to him the
 said Barham Wynn his heirs executors, administrators & assigns forever and
 they the said Samuel Champion and Elizabeth his wife for themselves
 their heirs executors, administrators and assigns doth covenant to and with
 the said Barham Wynn his heirs executors, administrators & assigns that the said
 land is free and clear of all incumbrances whatsoever
 hereby warranting and defending the legal title thereof
 not only against themselves but against the claims of
 all and every person whatsover
