This Indenture made and entered into this 24th day of
 November in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and eighteenth
 Between Valentine Senkins of the first part John Urquhart of the
 second part and Samuel B. Hummerell of the third part all of the
 County of Southampton and state of Virginia. Witnesseth that the
 said Valentine Senkins for and in consideration of the sum of two
 twenty three Dollars and eighty three cents which said sum is
 justly due from the said Valentine Senkins to the said John
 Urquhart by bond bearing date the 11th day of November 1817
 as well as all other monies which may be due and owing from
 the said Senkins to the said Urquhart by means of any dealing
 transfer of debts or paper whatsoever, and also for and in consideration
 of the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said Samuel B.
 Hummerell the Receipt whereof the said Valentine Senkins doth hereby
 acknowledge, hath granted and sold and by these presents doth hereby
 grant, bargain, sell, convey and make over unto the said Samuel B. Hummerell
 and his heirs the following property to wit one negro girl
 Parthenia. To have and to hold with all the right and int. of the said
 Valentine Senkins herein conveyed or intended to be conveyed to him the
 said Samuel B. Hummerell his heirs and assigns forever upon this
 special Trust. Nevertheless that the said Saml. B. Hummerell upon
 being thereto required by the aforesaid John Urquhart shall proceed
 to sell the aforesaid property to wit one negro girl Parthenia
 by public auction or intended to be conveyed by the aforesaid Valentine
 Senkins unto him the said Samuel B. Hummerell after advertising
 the time and place in the said County of Southampton for ten
 days previous at some public house or place for Cattle and such of
 the money arising out of or from the said Sale in the best
 place, time and manner as shall be deemed best by the said Samuel B.
 Hummerell as the aforesaid attesting this conveyance and then pay off
 the bond aforesaid with int. as well as all other monies which
 may be justly due and owing to the said John
 Urquhart from the said Valentine Senkins by reason of
