This Indenture made and entered into this tenth day of November one thousand eight hundred and eighteenth between Alfred S. Bailey of the County of Sumr of the one part, as trustee for Edward Bailey & Johnson Williford and Edwin Williford admrs of Johnson Williford dec^d of the second part. Witnesseth that whereas by an Indenture bearing date June 21st 1817 between the said Johnson Williford and Edwin Bailey also the said Alfred S. Bailey. There was conveyed by the said Johnson Williford one hundred and thirty two acres of land adjoining the lands of Joshua Britton Burd Harwell &c which was granted, bestowed, sold &c to the said Alfred S. Bailey as Trustee to secure the payment of a certain sum of money due to the said Edw^d Bailey by note given by the said Johnson Williford. by reference to the said indenture will more fully appear which was deposited in the Clerk's office of the County of Southampton, nineteenth day of December 1818 to be recorded. And whereas the said Alfred S. Bailey having rec^d the full amount of principal & interest of whatever the said indenture specified. The said Alfred S. Bailey is now by this Indenture willing to release and to the heirs of Johnson Williford dec^d the above named piece of land say one hundred and thirty two acres. Now Witnesseth that the said Alfred S. Bailey as well for & in consideration of the premises of the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid by Edwin Williford as a part of the said Johnson Williford dec^d at & before the sealing & delivery of these presents. The receipt whereof the said Alfred S. Bailey doth hereby acknowledge. hath granted, released & forever quit claim & by these presents do release & quit claim unto the heirs of Johnson Williford dec^d or to Edwin Williford admr. forever all the right title claim &c whatever of him the said Alfred S. Bailey as Trustee for the said one hundred & thirty two acres of land conveyed by Deed in Trust as above mentioned & that neither the said Alfred S. Bailey nor his heirs &c shall have any claim to the same in return whereof the said Alfred S. Bailey hath hereunto set his hand & affixed his seal the day & date first above written
