This Indenture made the 16th day of January
 in the year of our Lord 1819 between Nancy Barnett of the one part
 and Samuel Turner of the other part both of the County of
 Southampton State of Virginia. Metwitseth that said
 Nancy Barnett for and in consideration of the sum of four
 hundred and forty Dollars to her in hand paid by Samuel
 Turner at the time living and delivery of these presents the receipt
 whereof the said Nancy Barnett both hereby acknowledges and
 herself doth acquit the s^d Turner his heirs and assigns both
 granted, bargained, sold, aliened, conveyed and confirmed and made
 over and by these presents doth grant bargain, sell, alien, convey
 and make over unto the said Samuel Turner his heirs and assigns
 forever one certain tract or parcel of land containing fifty with
 or more or less, it being part of the land belonging to the
 Estate of Benjamin Turner dec^d beginning of six acres pine
 at the old road near Charles Newtons house the corner of Parker
 Barnetts land said land, thence a south east course to a pine
 standing in wolfpit branch a corner of John Whitheads
 said land, thence a course to a pine a corner of Jane Turners
 said land, thence a north course through the Cornfields to Mrs. Jamies-
 sons, thence along that line to a small red oak a corner of
 said Turner and s^d land near Nathans Spring, thence a west course
 to a red oak a corner of Parker Barnetts and John Turners
 said land at the corner of the orchard, thence a South course
 down the old road to the beginning at Newtons house, thence
 and to hold the said land premises with the appurtenances ther-
 unto belonging unto the s^d Turner his heirs and assigns forever the
 said Nancy Barnett both hereby promises and covenants for herself and
 heirs that they shall give forever warrant & affect the right title of
 the above mentioned land premises to make with the said Samuel Turner
 his heirs and assigns forever. In witness whereof I have set my
