This Indenture made this thirtieth day of November
 in the year one thousand eight hundred and eighteen Between Edwin
 Williford and Dolly his wife of the one part and Joshua Parrette of the
 other part, all of the County of Southampton, Virginia that they the
 Edwin Williford (and Dolly his wife for advice consideration of the sum
 of three hundred and thirty Dollars to them in hand paid by the said
 Joshua Parrette the receipt whereof they do hereby acknowledge, hath given
 granted, bargained & sold, and by these presents do give, grant bargain & sell
 to the said Joshua Parrette & his heirs and assigns, thirty three acres of
 land be the same more or less which is a part of a piece of land
 whereon Johnson Williford deceased did live lying on the south side of a
 swamp known by the name of Jarvis Swamp and in the County of
 Southampton bounding on the sd Joshua Parrette & David Hamill, to have
 and to hold the said tract or parcel of land with all its appurtenances, to
 him the said Joshua Parrette and his heirs forever and the said Edwin Williford
 and Dolly his wife their heirs &c shall and will forever warrant & defend the
 sd Parrette whereof the said Edwin Williford and Dolly his wife hath
 humbly set their hands & affixed their seals the day & year above written
