This Indenture made this thirtieth day of November
 in the year one thousand eight hundred and eighteen between Edwin
 Willeford and Dolly his wife of the one part on the Joshua Parrett of the
 other part, all of the County of Southampton, Virginia that they the
 said Edwin Willeford and Dolly his wife for and in consideration of the sum
 of three hundred and thirty Dollars to them in hand paid by the said
 Joshua Parrett, the receipt whereof they do hereby acknowledge, have given
 granted, bargained & sold, and by these presents do give, grant, bargain & sell
 to the said Joshua Parrett & his heirs and assigns, their three acres of
 land be the same more or less which is a part of a piece of land
 whereof Joshua Willeford deceased did live lying on the south side of a
 Swamp known by the name of Jarrison Swamps and in the County of
 Southampton, bearing on the N Joshua Parrett & David Hamill, Sr. and
 on to hold the said tract or parcel of land with all its appurtenances, to
 him the said Joshua Parrett and his heirs forever and the said Edwin Willeford
 and Dolly his wife their heirs &c shall and will forever warrant & defend the
 said Joshua Parrett whose the said Edwin Willeford and Dolly his wife have
 hereunto set their hands & affixed their seals the day & year above written
