 County bearing date January 12th 1819 personally appeared before us in chancery
 County aforesaid and being examined by us privately and apart from her said
 husband and having the said aforesaid fully explained to her that the
 said Cherry Luter acknowledged the same to be her act and deed and
 declared that she had willingly signed sealed and delivered the same and
 that she wished not to retract it, given under our hands and seals this
 12th day of January 1819.

Mary Gray This Indenture made this eighteenth day of January
 in the year one thousand eight hundred and nineteen between Robert Magee
 and Miss Magee his wife of the County of Sussex of the one part & Thomas
 Gray of the County of Southampton of the other part, Witnesseth that the
 said Robert Magee for and in consideration of the sum of four hundred
 Dollars unto him in hand paid by the said Thomas Gray the receipt whereof
 is hereby acknowledged, that he granted bargain sold alien released
 confirmed, and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien release &
 confirm unto the said Thomas Gray one certain tract or parcel of land
 containing fifty five and one half acres, in the same more or less lying and
 being in the County of Southampton being the same which the said
 Robert Magee purchased of Samuel Pope and Dineen his wife as is
 recd in the County of Southampton aforesaid and bounded as follows
 to wit Beginning at a forked oak in the Thomas Gray line thence
 by a line of marked trees South nine degrees west five hundred and
 forty six poles to a black gum in the mile Swamp thence down
 the stream of the said Swamp to a maple as corner tree in
 Thomas Gray line thence along the said Gray line to a black
 gum by the run of a branch thence up the run of the
 branch to a pine in the said Gray line thence along
 the said Gray line to the beginning with the
