Daniel deceased who holds of her right in said land as aforesaid  
Specified, bearing date the 8<sup>th</sup> day of January 1819 personally appeared  
before us in our County whereof fully inclined to be parties  
said Elizabeth Christopher aforesaid to the same to be her act and  
did also declare that she has willingly signed and affixed her name to the  
same and that she wished not to withdraw the same from her  
hands and seals this 15<sup>th</sup> day of February 1819
