 and declared that she had willingly signed, sealed & acknowledged
 the same and that she wished not to retract its provisions
 under our hands and seals this 15th day of January 1819

Southampton County In the Clerk's office the 18th day of Jan'y 1819
 This Indenture was proved by the oaths of Allen Edwards John Griffin
 and Joel Prashaw the witnesses thereto together with the Certificate thereon
