 in the County of Southampton, and bounded as follows To wit, Beginning
 at a lightwood post a corner of Brittain Davis sent line and of Mary Wellons
 line, thence along the said Wellons line, to a pine a corner of said Wellons
 line, thence by William Atkinson line to a willow oak a corner of said
 Atkinson line, thence by William Crues line to the horse fence branch
 thence up the various corners of the said branch to James West line thence
 along the said West line to Brittain Davis sent line thence along the said
 Davis line to the beginning and the reversion and reversions, remainders
 and remainders, unto the said Delilah Jones her heirs and assigns also all the
 estate, right, title interest, claims and demands of them the said William
 Jones, his heirs of in and to said land and every part thereof. To have
 and to hold this said land and premises with the appurtenances herein
