

and costs thereon accruing or in case the said Edwin Lewis, Richard B. Day, shall actually suffer, or be compelled to pay the debt of any of them, then, and in that case, it shall be lawful for the said Edwin Lewis, Middleton out of the proceeds of the said sale to pay and satisfy the said Lewis and Day any sum or sums of money which they may be compelled to pay on account of the said debt, as aforesaid, and the said Thomas R. Callier, Esq. by his agents and assigns the right and title of the said negroes (names Charles, Ned, and Molly, against himself, his heirs and administrators) and against all and every person or persons whatsoever.
