 bearing date the 18th day of January 1819 personally appeared before
 us in our County, and being examined by us privily and apart from
 her husband, and having the said appearance fully explained to her
 she the said Susannah Barnett, acknowledged the same to be her act
 and deed, and declared that she had willingly signed, sealed & delivered
 the same, and that she wishes not to retract if given under our
 hands and seals this 18th day of January 1819

This Indenture made this 11th day
 of September in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand eight hundred
 and twentieth. Between Drury Williams and Eliza Williams his wife
 of the County of Southampton and parish of Muttonay of the one part
 and J. W. Williams of the same County and Parish of the other part.
 Witnesseth that the said Drury Williams and Eliza his wife for and
 in consideration of the sum of one hundred and sixty Dollars good
 and lawful money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said
 J. W. Williams the receipt whereof the said Drury Williams and
 Eliza his wife doth hereby acknowledge, themselves fully and
 amply ~~being~~ satisfied and paid both quarters long since
 sold, aliened, enbilled and confirmed and by these presents doth
 grant bargain and sell unto the said J. W. Williams one
 certain tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the
 County of ~~Hampton~~ aforesaid containing by estimation one
