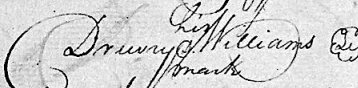

 hold the same to him and to his heirs forever and the said
 Drury Williams and Eliza Williams his wife for themselves
 their heirs executors and administrators doth by these presents
 Covenant agree to and with the said Drury Williams his heirs
 and assigns that they will by these presents warrant and
 forever defend all the right of said land unto the said Drury
 Williams against the claim of any other person or persons
 claiming or demanding the same. In witness whereof
