B. Wrenn
to

made the 29th day of September in the year of our Lord Christ 1818. Between David Wrenn and Mary his wife of the County of Davidson & State of Georgia, Nancy Blanton, Thomas Wrenn, Rebbecca Wrenn his wife, Samuel Champion & Elizabeth his wife heirs & legatees of Benjamin Wrenn deceased of the County of Southampton of the one part & Barbara Wrenn, one other legatee of said estate of the other part witnesseth that the said David Wrenn & Mary his wife Nancy Blanton, Thomas Wrenn and Rebbecca His wife Samuel Champion & Elizabeth his wife heirs & legatees as aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar to them in hand paid the receipt of which they do hereby acknowledge but more especially in consideration of this the said Barbara Wrenn being a widow in the estate of the said Benjamin Wrenn deceased have given granted and delivered to her the said Barbara Wrenn one certain tract or parcel of land situated lying and being in the County of Southampton, State of Virginia and bounded as follows: beginning at a postmark tree on the side of the main run of racoon swamp a corner for Robert Nicholson and Sam'l Champion. then up the main run of the swamp to the mouth of Deep branch near the mill. then up the deep branch to a small branch then up the small branch to a large dead oak a new made corner for the mill tract, thence S 41° W 27° pr. to a fine new made corner on edge of the mill pond. then up main run of the mill pond to the beginning of a new dividing line which begins in the pond and runs N. 37° E. by the east end of an old dam to a willow oak a new made corner for Nancy Blanton in a branch, thence down the branch its various courses to an elm a maidenhair in Blom line, then along Blom line to a post oak a corner on side of the road. then along the road toward Raccoon swamp bridge to a Spanish oak a corner of Batts & Wrenn on the side of the road then S 70° W 15° to a branch then down the main run of the branch to an overhanging cliff tree then down the branch to main run of Raccoon
