the three creeks (and containing by two different patents two hundred
and twenty acres be the same more or less and bounded as followeth
Beginning at a white oak in corner of James Lunday's (and the said
George Soy's line to Philips Soy's line, thence along the said Soy's line
to James Soy's line, thence along the said Soy's line to James
Soy's line, thence along the said Soy's line to the beginning
to have and to hold the said tract of land and premises together
with all and singular the rights and privileges and appurtenances
therunto belonging as in and unto more appertaining unto the said
Henry Soy his heirs and assigns forever and that said George Soy
for himself and his heirs and assigns will warrant and forever
defend the right and title of the said land and premises unto the
said Henry Soy his heirs and assigns forever against the lawfull
claim or demands of all (and every person) offenders whatsoever
claiming by from or under him the said George Soy his heirs or
assigns, or otherwise to the only proper use and behoof of him the
said Henry Soy his heirs and assigns forever. In witness whereof

the day of April 1799. This indenture was
procured by the oaths of Robert Mabry (and George Mason too of
the witnesses thereto) and continued, and at a Court held for the said
County the 13th of March 1819, William Edmunds the other witness
to the deed being dead Humphrey Drury (and Swift Harris being
soon deposed that verily believe the signature of the said
William Edmunds as a witness to the deed due to be
wholly in the own proper hand writing whereupon the
said deed is ordered to be recorded.
