This Indenture made and entered this thirtieth
day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
hundred and nineteen between Benjamin Barnes and Elizabeth
his wife of the County of Southampton of the one part and
Bolling H. Barnes of the said County of Southampton of the other
part all of the County of the State of Virginia. Witnesseth that
the said Benjamin Barnes for and in consideration of the sum of six
hundred and eighty dollars current money of Virginia to him by
the said Bolling H. Barnes in hand paid or received to be paid
the receipt whereof the said Benjamin Barnes doth hereby
acknowledge, hath granted, conveyed, sold and conveyed and by
these presents doth grant, convey, sell and convey unto the said
Bolling H. Barnes his heirs and assigns a certain tract or
parcel of land, containing by estimation one hundred and
thirty acres be the same more or less, lying and being in
the County of Southampton in said Duke of Dorset's land
to wit, beginning at a fine corner tree in John Barnes
line, thence along the said line to the well set boundary line
the said boundary to the city prison, thence along the said
city prison to the Ruty branch down the city branch to the
corner gum of Simon Pappas and Benj. Morris, thence along
Benj. Morris to a large tree called Brattle's
Pappas and along the same to the beginning. It is here
