of Henry Barrow dec'd by their next friend David Harris Esqrs
and the said Henry R. Williams and Charlotte his wife late
Charlotte Turner defendants have granted bargained sold
aliened, enfeoffed and confirmed, and by these presents do grant
bargain, sell, alien, enfeoff and confirm unto the said Richard
Barrow Henry Barrow John Thomas Barrow Narcissa Barrow
and Elizabeth Barrow heirs of Henry Barrow dec'd their
heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of
Land containing twenty four acres with all and singular
the appurtenances thereto belonging sit lying and being in the
County of Southampton and bounded as follows to wit
Beginning at a pine the north side of Simmons's road
in the middle of the same running along Henry Barrow's
line South eighty degrees east one hundred & sixty six pole
to a maple tree thence runs branch thence up the said
branch to a large pine a corner in John Fitzhugh's line
thence along the line of Thomas Fitzhugh thence to a
Pine to a small pine at the corner of the
road thence along the line of Mrs Charlotte Turner to the
beginning. To have and to hold the said twenty four
acres with all and singular the appurtenances thereto
