 the money arising from the sale in the first place pay and
 satisfy all costs attending the same as well as the expense of
 this conveyance and then pay the said Benjamin Snow the amount
 sum of five hundred twenty nine dollars and 34 cents with legal
 interest from the date of these presents as well as all other monies
 which may hereafter due and owing from the said Samuel Pond to
