

This Indenture made this 3rd day of January in
 the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and six minutes between
 Tyler Edwards and Temperance his wife both of the County of Hampton
 and State of Virginia of the one part and William Peale of the same
 County and state of the other part witnesseth that he doth Tyler
 Edwards and Temperance his wife for and in consideration of the
 sum of three hundred dollars of me lawful money of Virginia
 to them in hand paid by the said William Peale doth accept
 whereof the said Tyler Edwards and Temperance his wife doth
 acknowledge themselves fully and amply satisfied and paid by
 these presents doth grant bargain sell alien and confirm unto
 the said William Peale his heirs and assigns forever one certain
 tract or parcel of land and premises situated lying and
 being in the County of Southampton and parish of St. Thomas
 containing by estimation 54 acres to the Sompson road & up
 and bounded as follows viz Beginning at a dead spine
 stump a corner of James Daynes aining thence 59 rods N.E. to a
 sashrod old corner of Isabell Johnson James Souner & William
 Williams thence 54 rods N.E. to a small branch thence 55 rods N.E.
 pole to a large spine on the side of small branch thence down the
 said branch 50 rods to a nine corner of James Peale & William
 Williams thence N.E. 4 rods to the road thence up the various
 corners thereof to a path leading to the first station thence 58 rods E. 30
 rods to the first station together with all houses out houses &c
 belonging or otherwise appertaining to this said tract or parcel
 of land and promises to have and to hold the same to him the said
 William Peale to him and his heirs forever and the said Tyler
 Edwards & Temperance his wife for themselves for their heirs
 doth by these presents covenant and grant to and with the said
 William Peale his heirs &c that they will warrant and forever
 defend all right title claim or demand of any person or persons
 claiming or demanding the same or any part or part thereof
 witnesseth whereof the said Tyler Edwards and Temperance his wife
 hath countersigned their hands and affixed their seals the day and date
