This Indenture

made this 30th day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighteen between John Leitchlow and Mary his wife of the one part, and Henry Bridges of the other part, all of the County of Southampton and parish of the Hollway, Wiltshire, that for and in consideration of the sum of seven hundred and fifty Dollars in hand paid to the said John Leitchlow and Mary his wife, by the said Henry Bridges at or before the making of this indenture the receipt whereof they do hereby acknowledge, the said John Leitchlow and Mary his wife have granted, conveyed and sold by their presents, do grant, convey, sell, alien and confirm unto him the said Henry Bridges his heirs and assigns forever, one certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County and parish aforesaid, containing one hundred and fifty two acres more or less and bounded as follows beginning at a post set in the Oaktree road, a corner in Samuel Drewry's line, thence along the said Samuel Drewry's line, and the line of the land of Joseph Drewry dec'd North 84 degrees east to a brickery in corner of the land of Joseph Drewry dec'd in Henry Bridges's line, thence along the said Henry Bridges's line to a post set at a corner of Thomas Butts's land in the said Henry Bridges's line thence along the said Thomas Butts's line South 84 degrees west to the said Oaktree road, thence along the said road to the beginning. To have and to hold the said one hundred and fifty two acres of land with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging unto Henry Bridges his heirs and assigns forever, to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Henry Bridges his heirs & assigns forever, and the said John Leitchlow and Mary his wife doth furthermore their heirs executors and administrators covenant and agree with the said Henry Bridges his heirs and assigns and assigns that they will warrant and defend forever the above mentioned land and premises from all persons whatsoever, claiming from them or any other person whatsoever.
