This Indenture made this 16th day of April in
 the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & nineteen between Wm.
 Bailey of the County of Southampton of the one part & James Harris of the
 same County of the other part. Witnesseth that for and in consideration of
 the sum of six hundred and eighty one dollars to him the said Wm. Bailey
 in money paid by the said James Harris the receipt whereof is hereby
 acknowledged by the said Wm. Bailey hath granted bargained & sold to the
 said James Harris a certain tract or parcel of land situate
 lying and being in the County of Southampton on the south side of
 that three creeks and bounded as follows to wit beginning at a
 small white oak sapling a corner between the said James Harris
 Kinchen Williams and the said land south 77 west 44 pole to a
 gum thence north 19 west 69 1/2 poles to a white oak in Nathan
 Sprag line, thence up the long meadow branch as it meanders to
 a maple in Edwards Lundy's line, thence along his line south 12 west
 53 poles to a white oak thence south 73 west 62 1/2 poles to a
 stump by E. Lundy's pond thence 548 east 91 poles thence 8
 20 east 20 poles, thence north 75 east 33 poles to a pine in Pusan
 J. Lundy's line & a corner of Nathan Williams's land along his line
 north 44 west 56 poles to a white oak at a spring of
