the same, and the money and property received by virtue of this In-
strument to apply to the use of him the said Henry Linn and his
heirs and I do further authorize and empower the said Henry Linn
his heirs and assigns to do and execute all and every
this act and acts, requisite for receiving, receiving & obtaining the
said money and property or any part thereof and for his benefit
aforesaid lawfully and effectually to all intents and purposes as if I
were personally present hereby ratifying and confirming whatsoever
my said attorney shall lawfully do or cause to be done in or
about receiving, receiving & obtaining the aforesaid money & property
given under my hand and seal the fourth day of November
in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighteenth
& of American Independence Forty two
