This Indenture made this 27th day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty-two, between Edmund Thorp and Mary his wife formerly John Spencer and Susanpah Spencer his wife, formerly Susanmah Thorp and Nancy Thorp and Joshua Thorp, all of the County of Sampson and State of Virginia, and Joseph Oliver and Tabitha Oliver his wife, formerly Tabitha Thorp of the County of Northampton State of North Carolina of the one part, and Henry Welch of the County of Pamlico Town of Monroe, and State of Virginia of the other part, Witnesseth that the said Edmund Thorp and Mary his wife, John Spencer and Susanmah his wife, Nancy Thorp, Joshua Thorp of the County of Sampson and State of Va. and Joseph Oliver and Tabitha his wife of the County of Northampton and State of North Carolina for and in consideration of the sum of Five hundred and ten Dollars good and lawful money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said Henry Welch the receipt whereof the said Edmund Thorp and Mary his wife, John Spencer and Susanmah his wife, Nancy Thorp and Joshua Thorp of the County of Sampson and State of Virginia, Joseph Oliver and Tabitha his wife, doth acknowledge themselves fully and amply satisfied and of good birth, grant, bargain, sell, alien, release and confirm and their heirs, assigns, heirs, assigns, heirs, assigns, heirs, assigns, heirs, assigns unto the said Henry Welch to him and to his heirs assigns one certain tract or parcel of land and premises, situate, lying and being in the County and State of Virginia aforesaid and also in the parish of Saint-Luke and near the Town of Monroe, and bounded as follows to wit: Beginning at a post oak a cr. of Samuel Brown thence N. 24. W. 14. pole to a black gum tree a cr. in a branch, variation in the line, thence N. 8. W. 68 pole to a cr. on the line, thence N. 22. W. 90 pole to a pine a cr. of Benj. Whitfield and Jeremiah Drake, thence S. 55. W. 132 pole to a large oak and a small white oak a cr. of Benj. Whitfield thence S. 33. E. 60 pole to a black gum in the deep branch a cr. of Benj. Whitfield, thence S. 55. W. 53 pole to a white oak cr. at the road leading from Monroe to Vicks church, thence S. 70. E. 40 pole variation in the line, thence S. 85. E. 148 pole to the first station containing by calculation survey of the County surveyor one hundred and two acres be the same more or less, together with all houses, out houses, edifices, buildings, yards, gardens, orchards, mays, waters (and water courses) whatever, belonging or in any wise appertaining to the said tract or parcel of land and premises To have and to hold the same unto the said Henry Welch to him and to his heirs assigns and the said Edmund Thorp and Mary his wife, John Spencer and Susanmah his wife, formerly Susanmah Thorp, Nancy Thorp and Joshua Thorp of the County of Sampson and State of Virginia, and Joseph Oliver and Tabitha Oliver, formerly
